## WOMENS BASEBALL INFORMATION SHEET

Manly Eagles Baseball are looking at entering a Women's team into the New South Wales Women's Baseball League (NSWWBL) Second Grade Competition.

This Competition is played on Friday nights across the Sydney Metropolitan area.

Grounds include, Aquatic Ballpark, Greenway Park (Cherrybrook), Blacktown International Sportspark, Laybutt Reserve (Blacktown), Gilchrist Oval (Macarthur), Phil Austin Reserve (Kogarah), Bonnet Bay (Cronulla), Andrews Road Reserve (Penrith), Kellyville.

Games are 2 hours long and are played on a full size diamond, with pitchers throwing from 60ft-6in. All games are umpired by at least 1 Official umpire provided by the league.

Training will be held one night a week, preferably at Aquatic and on either a Wednesday or Thursday night. On some Wednesday nights the Manly Eagles Men's First Grade will be playing at home so space will be limited during those games should Wednesday be the choice of training night.

We have the opportunity to align ourselves with one of the First Grade Women's clubs. First Grade play on Saturday afternoon's at similar venues to the Second Grade competition. This would give any Manly player the opportunity to get First Grade experience if and when they feel they would be up to it. This also can work in our favour allowing players from the First Grade club to come and fill in and play should we be short on numbers or for that player to get more game time outside of First Grade.

Cost of registration for the Women's Competition will be between \$320-\$450. This is to be finalised once the fees are released by BNSW. If you are playing in a junior competition, this fee will be cheaper. There will also be an opportunity for you to help reduce your fees through one of our upcoming fundraisers.
