Manly Baseball Regional Sport Organisation (RSO) – the “Board”



NOTES:

RSO (the “Board”):

- Responsible for the governance of Manly Warringah District Baseball Association, including the Junior Competition, Junior Representative and Minor League Sub-committees.
- The Board is comprised of a delegate from the five affiliated clubs (MEBC, Forest, Manly Seaside, Pittwater & Warringah) and a delegate from the JCC, JRC and MWMLC. The club delegates are members of each club’s committees.
- The JCC & MWMLC committees are comprised of elected members who nominate to participants in those committees. The JRC members are appointed by the Board via nomination.
- The Board Executive comprises the President, Secretary and Treasurer. Appointed by the club Board delegates on application. The applicants are members of their respective Club committee and/or hold special qualifications that may be applicable to the nominated position.

JCC

- Responsible for the management of the Junior Competition held in the Spring/Summer. The competition participates under the Little League International (LLI) model, comprising Tee-ball (under 9), Zooka, Minor League, Major League, Intermediate League, Junior League and Senior League.
- A non-competitive under 8 Tee-ball division and several clubs operate a “Try Baseball” program for 4 – 7 years old.
- The competition is played on Saturday mornings, with exception of Intermediate League on Wednesday nights and Senior League on Friday nights.
- Intermediate League is composite age division, which allows participation through dual registration under age eligibility.
- Baseballers may participate through dual registration in Junior League and Senior League division under age eligibility.
- The four Junior Clubs provide a delegate to the JCC.
- The JCC Executive consists of President, Secretary and Competition Coordinator, appointed from nominated applicants.
- The JCC provide a delegate to the Board.

MWMLC

- Responsible for the management of the senior Minor League competition, which is non-representative baseball, comprising Spring/Summer, Winter and Masters Competitions.
- The Committee also runs short competitions under other formats, such as “Whole of family baseball”.
- Spring/Summer and Winter competitions are open to players, male or female, 15 years and older.
- The Masters competition is open to players male or female, 35 years or older. It is played as a short competition in the pre- and/or post the Christmas break.
- The MWML provide a delegate to the Board.

NOTES (continued):

JRC:

- Responsible for the Junior Representative Program (“All Stars”).
- Representative teams are selected to participate in all LLI divisions and Rookies (Zooka).
- Manages the participation in other affiliated, sanctioned representative competitions or programs.
- Manages and facilitates the Winter Development Program for applicant baseballers to enhance their skills during the “off-season”.
- The Committee comprises a Representative Coordinator, Secretary, Treasurer, Uniform/Equipment Manager and Social Media Manager, selected from nominating applicants. Additional positions may be included to meet other identified needs.
- The JRC provides a delegate to the Board.

MEBC:

- MEBC is an affiliated club that participates in three grades, under 18s and Women’s League of the NSW State League competition managed by Baseball NSW.
- Participants in 1st, 2nd and 3rd grade and Women’s League are senior baseballers, 15 years or older.
- Under 18’s is players 15 to under 18 (by the 31 December).
- 1st Grade through 18’s is played at Aquatic Baseball Park on Saturday for home rounds.
- Women’s League is played at Aquatic Baseball Park on Friday night for home rounds.
- MEBC provides a delegate to the Board.

MWBU

- Non-affiliated partner of the Manly Warringah Baseball Association.
- Provides umpires for all MWDBA and affiliated competitions.
- Provides training for MWDBA members of an appropriate age to become accredited umpires.
